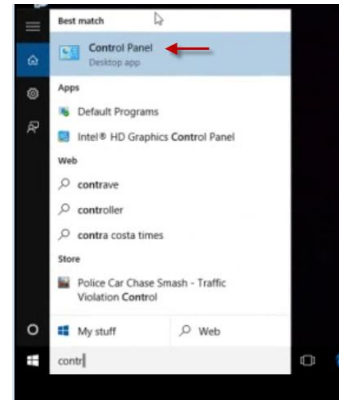
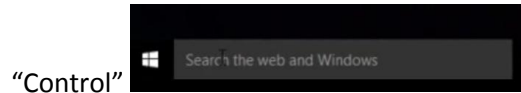


# Turn Off User Account Control in Windows 10

In windows 10 there are many ways to get to the Control Panel.

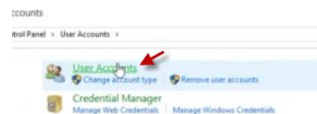
The easiest is to go to the start button and you will see next to it, a box that says “Search the Web and Windows” Click in it and type the word



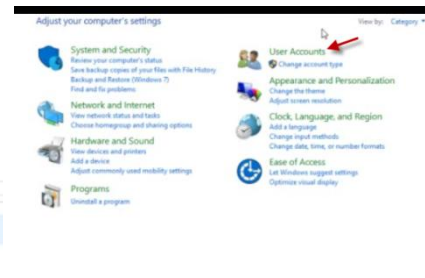
You will see the menu appear with the command “control panel” click on that.

Now you should be at the control panel main screen.

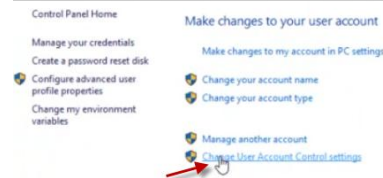
You will see on the top right side the words “User Accounts” in green, click on that.



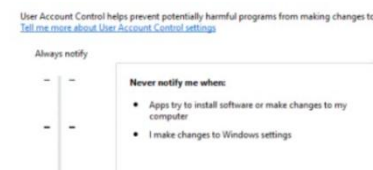
Then click on “User Accounts” again in Green.



Then at the middle of the screen at the bottom, in the you will see “ Change user account Control settings” Click on that.



Now you will see a slider, click and drag the slider to the bottom that says “Never notify” then click OK to exit. Now the UAC is off.



Then run the program as the Administrator, even thou you are the Administrator of your computer, Windows 10 makes you do this anyway. To do this, go to the Hardscape Imaging Software Shortcut on the desktop And put your mouse over the icon and “RIGHT Click” to bring up that menu you see here, and click on “Run as Administrator”
